#### **SVGK-JOURNEY SINCE 2015**

- In 2015 Punia Taruntirtha Club started a computer literacy center for the village kids with the help of Aurigene Discovery Technologies Ltd (Bangalore).
   Aurigene donated 6 used computer and Rs 20000 as start up fund.
- Punia Toruntirtha Club (PTC) started the school with the help of two volunteers and there was 15 students who just touched and felt keyboard first time in their life and slowly learned basic computing
- In 2017 with a CSR grant of 7.5L from Aurigene a decent size hall was built
  in a sponsored land in the village Punia and few new computers were also added.
  This time the institute was renamed as Swami Vivekananda Gramonnayan Kendra
  (SVGK). Due to high demand from surrounding villages within 5km radius SVGK
  started accommodating more students and also housewives to reach to 150+ learners.
- In 2017 we also built a video conferencing set up and started weekly spoken
   English classes with ~50 students through online mode using remote teachers.
- In 2018 with another CSR grant of 7.5L from Aurigene PTC built another hall to accommodate a telemedicine center, water and sanitation facility in the complex.
   A beautiful garden is also built and maintained by volunteers with minimum donation from the patrons of this institute. This center was used frequently in the time of pandemic to help local patients to connect them with remote doctors.
- In 2021 SVGK has been registered as a public trust and acquired all documents like PAN card, 12A, 80G, CSR-1 and NGO Darpan.
- At present SVGK has 375 students enrolled for diploma and basic computer education, 50 students in spoken English, ~50 students in yoga class, 40 students in dance class and 20 students in music class. Students are boys, girls and adults from farmer family and from different community and of mixed age group.
- A library has also been built with the help of old books donated by different donors (https://svgk.librarika.com/)
- The institute has applied to be recognized as a rural skill development center to state and central government agencies and the applications are pending approval.

## **SVGK Free Computer education**

- Present student strength: 375 students
- Eligibility of studentship: 5th standard and above (age and gender no burden)
- Class frequency: weekly 2 classes of 1h duration (both practical and theoretical)
- Courses taught: basic computing (dtp), diploma in basic computer languages
- Medium of instruction: bengali and english
- Season: periodic intake notification published on the institute's notice board and in the svgk website
- No. of computers available: 30 computers equipped with broad band internet connection

# **SVGK Free spoken English class**

- Present student strength: 50
- Eligibility of studentship: 5th standard and above (age and gender no burden)
- Class frequency: Weekly online class through videoconferencing
- Courses taught: Basic English Communication

### **SVGK-Other activities**

- SVGK Weekly Music and Dance Classes: Present student strength: 50; Eligibility of studentship: 5th standard and above (age and gender no burden)
   Courses taught: Freestyle, classical and folk
- **SVGK Telemedicine center:** This center helps in connecting patients to doctors from other cities across India for consultation. Volunteers from the center helps in making connection technically and acts as interpreter if needed by the patient
- **SVGK Library:** A library has been built with the help of old books donated by different donors. The library contain textbooks and storybooks suitable for children. Membership is free and the titles can be requested online (https://svgk.librarika.com/)
- **SVGK Gardening:** SVGK volunteers has created a well-maintained garden on the site. Basic gardening is also taught on the site to interested individual.
