ADMISSION:

- 1. Admission in all classes will be notified in the notice board of the center as well as in the web site of the organization.
- 2. No of students in each class will be fixed and will be decided by the function head.
- 3. Admission will be in the first come first served basis.
- 4. Application form will be provided by the center free of cost.
- 5. Application form must be submitted to the function head only.
- 6. Submission of application form doesn't guarantee admission.
- 7. In case admission couldn't be secured the form submission doesn't guarantee the admission to the next season. Fresh admission form needs to be submitted for every season.
- 8. Though **no tuition fee is charged** for the course there will be a nominal one-time admission fee collected during admission.
- 9. An instruction sheet, and other materials will be handed over by the function head during admission.
- 10. Book, and ID card and other study materials will be provided during admission with one-time nominal charge.

To get registered with us the student needs to visit to the SVGK computer center, fill up their 'Student Admission Form' and enclose- Xerox of the last educational qualification document(s). The SVGK office will fill up the admission form online on behalf of the student and after verifying the admission form SVGK Head Office will provide a unique Admission number to every student.

COURSES

Exams:

- 2. 50% of the total marks will be accounted from the unit tests and other 50% will be from the final exam.
- 3. 40% marks to be secured for successful completion of each course.
- 4. A certificate will be issued to all successful learners.
